

## **FINDING DNAe**

Street Address: 56 Wood Lane, Ugli Campus Block C, LONDON W12 7SB

Landmarks: Opposite the Television Centre. Between White City and Wood Lane tube stations.

### **FROM HEATHROW AIRPORT**

Take the Heathrow Express to Paddington (15 minutes) and the Underground (Circle or Hammersmith and City Line - Westbound) to Wood Lane (18 minutes).

*or*

Take the Underground (Piccadilly Line - Eastbound) to Hammersmith station (45 minutes). Change at Hammersmith for the Circle or Hammersmith and City Line - Eastbound and travel to Wood Lane (5 minutes).

### **FROM GATWICK AIRPORT**

Take a National Rail train to Victoria station (40 minutes). Change at Victoria for the Circle or District Line – Westbound and travel to Notting Hill Gate. Change at Notting Hill Gate to the Central Line – Westbound and travel to White City (7 minutes).

### **ON FOOT via London Underground**

We are located at the Ugli Campus which is situated between two stations: White City (Central Line) and Wood Lane (Circle or Hammersmith and City Line). Visit the TfL website for maps and directions from your origin [here](#).

### **BY BUS**

There are a number of routes that pass opposite the Ugli Campus. The selection below stop outside White City Underground station.

- **72** Roehampton > East Acton
- **95** Southall > Shepherds Bush
- **220** Wandsworth > Willesden Junction
- **272** Chiswick > Shepherds Bush

### **BY CAR**

We are located south of the A40. From the A40, take the A219 exit toward Harlesden/White City and turn right onto Wood Lane. We are approximately 0.4 miles away. Take the first left after White City Underground station.

There is metered parking in nearby streets and extensive parking at the Westfield Shopping Centre. Please note that there are limited parking spaces at the campus which can be arranged prior to the day of visit.

### **WHEN YOU ARRIVE**

The Ugli reception is located in Block A. From there, you will be directed to DNAe reception on Level 3 of Block C.
